DOCUMENTS TO BE BROUGHT AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION

1. Original Date of Birth certificate for verification, along with a copy for record.
2. Latest Address proof in the name of the parent: - (Any valid document as per Govt. of India specifications.)
3. Original SC/ST Certificate in the name of the child for verification along with a copy for record. (If applicable)
4. Original OBC Certificate in the name of the child for verification along with a copy for record. (If applicable)
5. Original Blood group certificate from any medical diagnostic lab.
6. Original Certificate, showing the disability, from Civil Surgeon (For physically handicapped candidates) for verification and a copy for records.
7. Service certificate with Details of transfer with distance between the stations from competent authority /Departmental Head (For service personnel).
8. Original Transfer Certificate from the School studied, along with UDISE / EMIS number.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. The Vidyalaya is having vacancies only in **Class V, VI and VII.**
2. The Registration Forms may be downloaded from the Vidyalaya website or can have a copy from the Office.
3. The Registration Forms complete in all respects and accompanied by all required Documents, must be submitted in the Office by 03:00 PM on 09.04.2018 (Monday).
4. All the Documents must be self-attested.
5. Admission may be granted based on Priority Category System (Cat. 1 to 5)
6. If applications are more than the number of seats vacant in a particular category and transfers, lottery system will be followed.
7. The student must have studied the subjects as per KVS / CBSE pattern, English, Hindi, Sanskrit (for class VII & VIII), Mathematics, Environmental Science / Science and Social Science.
8. There will not be any admission test up to class VIII.
9. For Class – IX, admission test will be conducted in English, Hindi, Math, Science and Social Science for 100 Marks (20 Marks each subject) and 3 hours, merit list will be prepared for each category of priority separately for admission.
10. Mere Registration will not confer the right of admission.
